The 21st World Congress of Accountants (WCOA) will be hosted by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI).

WCOA has been held under the auspices of the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC), the worldwide organisation for the accountancy profession, every four years.

The First World Congress dates back to 1904. ICAI, being a member of IFAC, had bid to host the WCOA 2022 and after rigorous assessment regarding the abilities and experience of the member body; suitability of proposed venue; attractiveness to potential delegates, including site visits by IFAC; ICAI won the bid to host the WCOA 2022 in Jio World Centre, Mumbai, India from 18 to 21 of November 2022.
